TITLE VI STATEMENT

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 states:

“No person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.”

City of Racine Transit operates its programs without regard to race, sex, color, or national origin. Copies of documents related to Title VI, EEO, and ADA are available from the office listed below. If a member of the public wishes to file a discrimination complaint against the transit system, it should follow the procedures outlined below.

COMPLAINT PROCEDURES

Title VI Discrimination Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

Any person who believes they have been subjected to discrimination in the delivery of or access to public transportation services on the basis of race, color, or national origin, may file a complaint with RYDE Racine. Such complaint must be filed in writing with RYDE Racine no later than 180 days after the alleged discrimination.
